Substitution Rule Change – Effective August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009

In the interest of not slowing down play, yet offering ample opportunities to enter players into the game, the youth board of the WI Youth Soccer Association at its June 2009 meeting modified the “at any stoppage” substitution rule enacted for the 2008-2009 soccer season. The change in the substitution rule pertains to all leagues and tournaments, with the exception of the WI Youth Soccer Association State Championship Tournament, that take place under the auspices of the WI Youth Soccer Association.

The modification to the substitution rule reads as following:

**Substitutions may be made prior to a throw-in in favor of your team, prior to a goal kick by either team, following a goal by either team, following an injury to a player from either team or at half time. Substitutions may also be made for your team on the opposing team’s throw-in if the opposing team also has a player at the half-way line. Remember that a substitute should only enter the field of play at the halfway line, during a stoppage of the match and after receiving a signal from the referee.**

**This rule is effective for the 2009-2010 soccer season beginning August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009.**
