

Kettle Moraine Soccer Association KMSA Fall 2006

All coaches and referees should review the Rules as written in the KMSL Policies and Procedures Manual. A copy is posted at KMSL.org. Along with these rules and modifications are incorporated the US Youth Soccer Official Playing Recommendations listed below which supersedes the old KMSL rules.

On U-7 and U-8

- **All kicks are indirect**
- **No score is kept**
- **All games are played 4 v 4**
- **Duration of Game:** 10 minute quarters

On U-10 or below

- **Offside:** None - but players may not “camp out” by goal
- **All games are played 6 v 6**
- **Duration of Game:** 12 minute quarters

On U-12

- **All games are played 8 v 8**
- **Duration of Game:** 30 minute halves

On U-14

- **Duration of Game:** 35 minute halves

On all small sided games (U-12 and below)

- **Substitutions:** Either team may substitute on any dead ball – throw-in, goal kick, corner kick, injury, and after a goal is scored

On all Age groups

- **Flip of Coin to Start Game:** Determines which goal winner of flip will attack. Loser of flip kicks off
- **5 Goal Rule:** Team down by 5 goals may add a player
- **Borrowing Players:** A team short of players may borrow from same or younger U-division to field a team – may not have substitutes. (U-7 & 8 teams field 4 players, U-10 teams field 6 players, U-12 teams field 8 players, and U-14 teams field 11 players)
